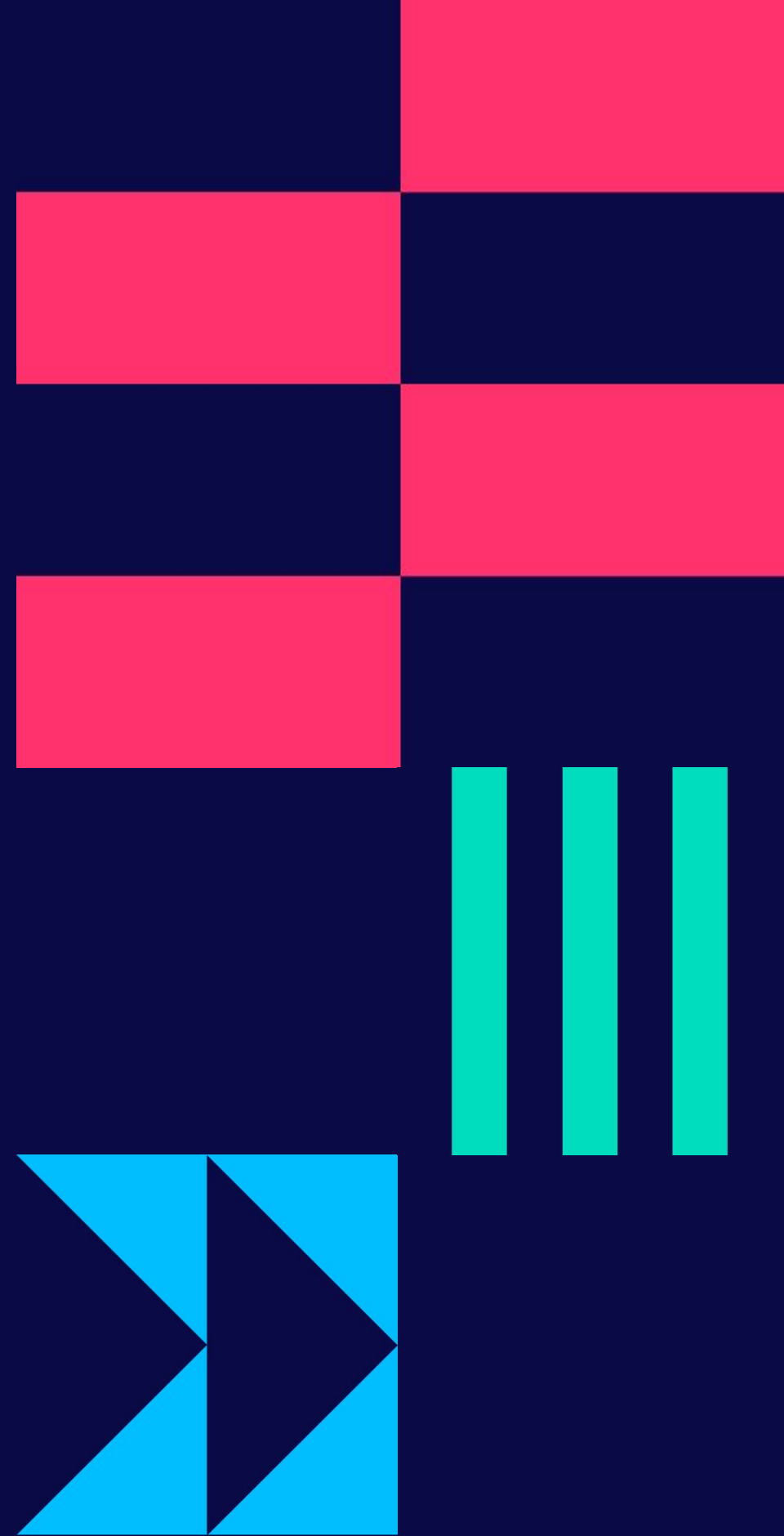

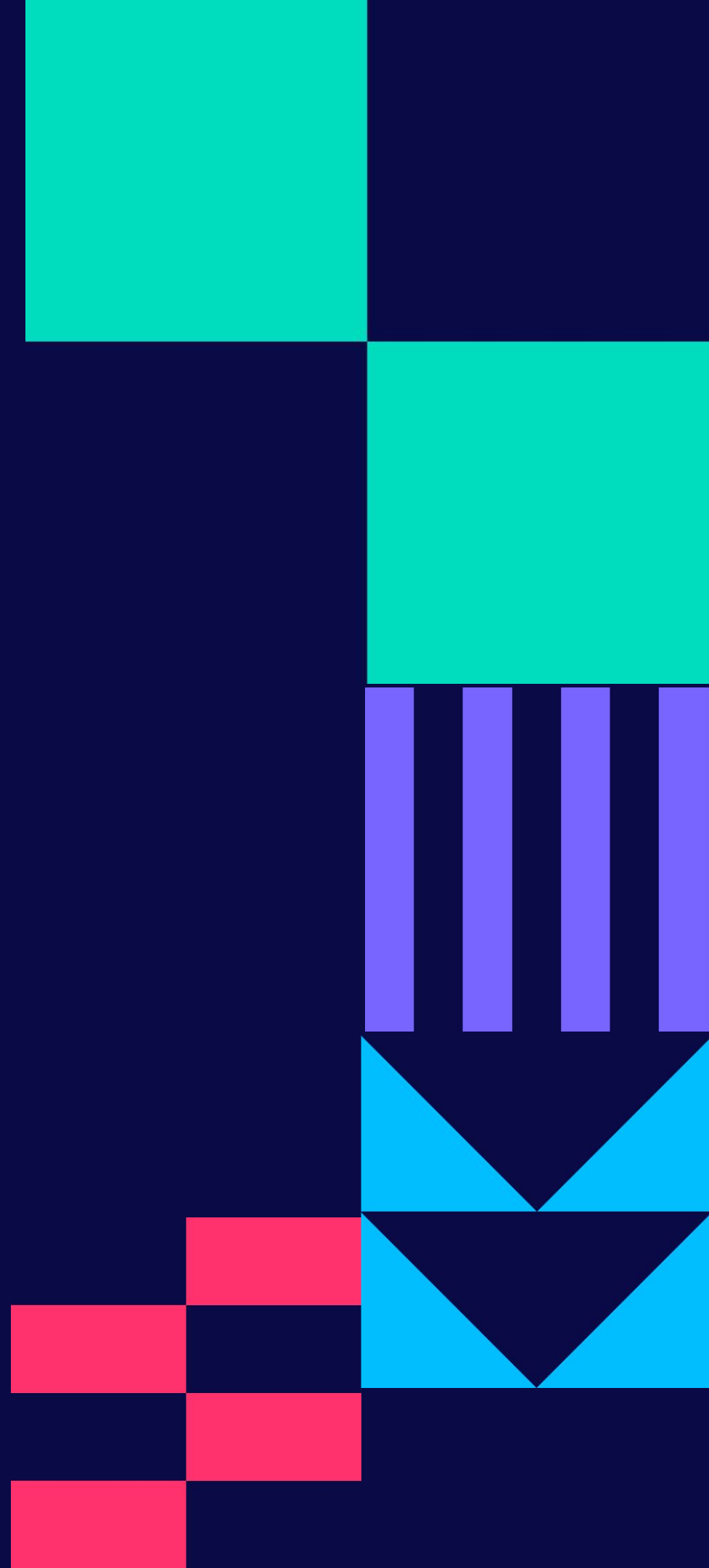
Code of conduct

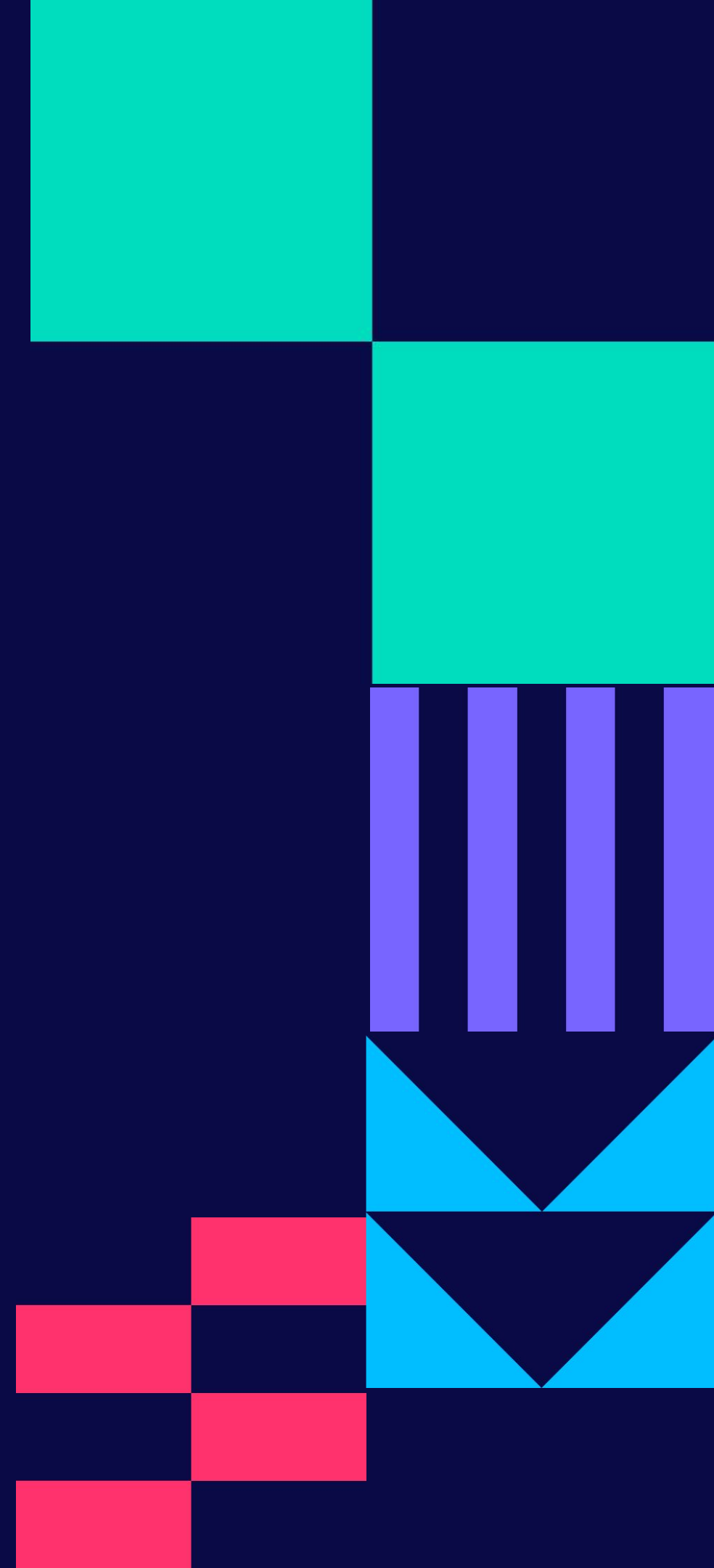
